Mary Harris Memorial Scholarship

Soroptimist International of Vacaville, a women's service organization, is searching for an exceptional woman to award a \$9000 scholarship, which will be paid out in \$3000 installments within 3 consecutive years. Applicants must be a graduate of a Vacaville Unified School District high school or a resident of Vacaville at the time of high school graduation.

The applicant must have achieved a high school GPA of 3.0 or above, be currently enrolled in an accredited two-year or four-year college or university, be a college freshman, or above, with a GPA of 3.0 or higher and must be working towards a B.A. or B.S. or graduate degree. Applications may be submitted after completion of the first semester of study; students in their 2nd, 3rd, or 4th year of college / university, especially those continuing on to graduate school are encouraged to apply. Depending on your length of study, you may receive funding for one, two, or the full three years.

The applicant must be majoring within the spectrum of Fine Arts, such as the Visual Arts, Dance, Music, and Culinary Arts; Literature, Creative Writing, Graphic Design, Marketing, Fashion, Enology or Viticulture.

All applications will be judged with anonymity and will be scored based upon financial need, grades, volunteerism / community activities, letters of recommendation, and submission of an essay and portfolio of work (if applicable to your area of study).

Awarding the scholarship for the 2nd year and 3rd year requires the committee receiving a college/university transcript, and if applicable, a current portfolio, verifying her progress, continuing with one of the approved major areas of study, a course load of 12 units or more per semester, maintaining good academic standing throughout the period of scholarship support, and minimum GPA of 3.0. If any of these requirements are not, the award money for 2nd or 3rd year will be forfeited

The deadline for applications is April 30, 2020. Electronic submission is encouraged.

We are pleased that you are interested in pursuing your college education and are applying for the Mary Harris Memorial Scholarship from Soroptimist International of Vacaville.

Eligibility:

Soroptimist International of Vacaville, a volunteer service organization, is offering its 2020 Mary Harris Memorial Scholarship to women who are graduates of a Vacaville Unified School District high school or were a resident of Vacaville at the time of high school graduation. Applicants must currently be enrolled in an accredited two-year or four-year college or university (freshman or higher) and working towards a four-year degree or have been accepted/are currently enrolled in graduate studies.

The applicant must be majoring within the spectrum of Fine Arts, such as the Visual Arts, Dance, Music, and Culinary Arts; Literature, Creative Writing, Graphic Design, Marketing, Fashion, Enology or Viticulture.

Those who wish to submit a qualifying application must have attained a high school GPA of 3.0 or above and have a current college GPA of 3.0 as well. The required documentation is listed on the Scholarship Application Form.

Submission requirements:

- **Scholarship Application**
- **Three** letters of recommendation are required. The letters may not be from family members and should be from persons related to your educational or employment endeavors. (See specifics on application) We want to learn about you from people who know you well and who are aware of your goals and aspirations. They should also understand your ability to accomplish goals, meet deadlines and must be aware of your work ethic.
- **Summary statement**
- **Essay**
- **HS transcripts (unofficial accepted)**
- **College transcripts (unofficial accepted)**
- **Proof of current college enrollment**
- **Financial need statement**

All criteria must be met in order to be eligible for these scholarships.
